Barefoot policy

This term we would like to introduce a 'barefoot policy' in our setting.

At Droxford Montessori we are extremely passionate about keeping up to date with the very latest research regarding every aspect of a child's development.

New research has shown that children who are able to participate in educational activities whilst barefoot experience many additional benefits.

From better concentration, to stronger feet and ankles improving balance and stimulation through the feet and soothing the nervous system.

If you wish to opt out, let us know.

In winter we recommend crocs or well fitting slippers.

Sound Box

To support individual literacy work, we have a sound box for group work. This covers one phonetic sound a week, starting with "a" in our second week back. We will follow the alphabet sequence each week, please see the board informing you of the letter/sound of that week.

We encourage the children to bring one object to their first session of the week and take it home at the last session of the week. We play games with the objects whilst learning the sound. If items can be named please do so. If an object can be eaten, we would all like to eat it!

We start the term with the letter O


Operating hours
